## **CONDITIONS**

- Fire must be supervised by an adult (18+) at all times.
- A charged hose and/or tools or water adequate to contain the fire within the fire site is required.
- Burning is not permitted when wind speeds exceed 30 KPH.
- Burning is not permitted during Provincial fire bans or when the Fire Chief has declared a high or extreme fire hazard.
- Fire must not create a nuisance, and care must be taken to prevent children from accessing the fire.
- Only clean products may be burned, burning pressure treated or creosote treated wood is prohibited.
- Burning Hours: Recreational from 10AM to 1AM. Land Clearing from 10AM to 9PM.
- All other provisions of By-law #2011-12 apply. The Fire Department may impose additional terms and conditions.
